Purpose of CARE:

To improve research participation and reduce health disparities in Alzheimer's disease, aging, caregiving, and other health issues in AANHPI communities through the creation of a health research registry of AANHPI adults who are interested in participating in various types of research.

Responsibilities:

- Promote CARE to the AANHPI communities
- Complete UCSF required training
- Conduct a minimum of 2 presentations/outreach efforts every 3 months
- Attend monthly group meetings
- Meet with CARE staff for monthly check-ins
- Commit approx. 5 hrs/wk to your ambassadorship

Qualifications

- Currently enrolled in high school or college, or a recent graduate
- Interested in conducting community outreach
- Ability to speak and read in English, though fluency in an AANHPI language is encouraged

A certificate of completion is given to ambassadors who have completed at least 3 months of requirements.
