NIH = National Institutes of Health

AAPIs = Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders

Did you know that less than 1% of NIH's budget was put towards AAPI-focused clinical research in 26 years?

Hey, I'm Pochi, and I'm here to share how to make a difference with CARE!

CARE stands for "Collaborative Approach for Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders Research and Education"!

CARE is a registry that helps AAPIs participate in research studies!

Studies may focus on health topics that affect AAPIs, who are often under-represented in clinical studies.

Sweet! But-a survey? I don't want anyone sharing my info...

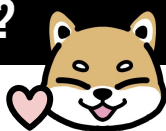
CARE does their best to keep any identifiable info, SECURE! Your info is safe with CARE!

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN CARE?



To be eligible for CARE, you must be:

- An Asian, Asian American and/or Pacific Islander
- An adult (18 years old or older)
- Able to read and speak in English, Mandarin, Cantonese, Korean, Samoan, Vietnamese, or Hindi
- Reside in the United States (US) or US Associated Pacific Islands (USAPI)
- Willing to be contacted to participate in potential future research in Alzheimer's and related dementias, aging, caregiving and/or other health topics across the lifespan

 - Health topics will vary and are diverse such as **Alzheimer's disease and related dementias, aging, caregiver-related research, and other health topics** across the lifespan for Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders.

HOW DOES CARE WORK?



Participants complete an online survey

Questions about socio-demographic background, contact information, health questions and research participation preferences.



Information is used to conduct studies

Researchers contact people to participate in their studies. Information that identifies you will be kept secure.



Information is used for future studies on AAPIs

Once the study is done using your information, we may share it with other researchers so they can use it for other studies in the future.
