Purpose of the CARE Registry

 Create a large registry (list) of AANHPI adults who can be contacted about potential research studies to participate in

Address the gap and reduce disparities in research among AANHPI

Target enrollment: 10,000 AANHPIs

Health topics can vary and diverse i.e. ADRD, aging, caregiver-related research, etc...



Who can participate? To be eligible for CARE, you must:

- Self-identify as Asian, Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and/or Pacific Islander
- Be 18 years old or older
- Able to read and speak one of the following languages: English, Cantonese, Mandarin, Hawaiian, Hindi, Ilokano, Japanese, Korean, Samoan, Tagalog, or Vietnamese

- Have an interest in participating in potential research





How to enroll


Participants need to complete a 10-15 minute survey either online or by phone

Participants will receive the option to receive a \$10 gift card after completing the registry survey

Available languages: English, Cantonese, Mandarin, Hawaiian, Hindi, Ilokano, Japanese, Korean, Samoan, Tagalog, Vietnamese







Survey Questions:

- Socio-demographic background
- Contact information
- General health questions
- Caregiving (if applicable)
- Research participation preferences



CARE officially launched on October 15, 2020



Expectations & Requirements

- Ambassadors will promote and engage with information from CARE Registry to their communities throughout their ambassadorship
- Complete UCSF required online trainings HIPAA and CITI trainings
- 2 presentation/outreach efforts **EVERY** 3 months
 - Host a virtual event, in-person event, emailing organizations
- Attend 1 individual check-in meeting per month
- Attend 1 group meeting per month
- Outreach tracking via outreach metrics survey

You will not receive an Ambassador completion certificate without completing requirements Outreach efforts, individual meetings, and group meetings are required **EVERY** 3 months
